- Have all passed a background check









SERVICES WE PROVIDE

K-12 Academic Tutoring & SEL Mentorship

We provide content-specific tutoring for students in grades K-12 who need extra support in any given subject area. Our holistic approach to tutoring prioritizes mentorship and social emotional learning.

Support for Students with Learning Differences

Our special education tutors can support students as they work to meet their IEP goals. Tutors review students' IEPs, attend IEP meetings, and partner with teachers and families to support students.

Home Hospital Tutoring Services

For students who are unable to attend school for physical or mental health reasons, we can work with school staff and families to develop an intensive, customized plan to keep the student up to speed.

English Language Learner Support

We offer support for English language learners at all levels. Our tutors help their ELL students achieve learning goals across content areas while strengthening their academic English skills.

Executive Functioning & Study Skills

For students who need support with organization, time management, and study habits, our trained tutors can provide focused coaching to develop strong executive functioning skills.

Learning Loss & Growth Acceleration

We can design customized enrichment programs and courses, including accredited AP classes. This is ideal for accelerated learners who need an extra challenge and for those in need of remedial support.




